# Auction Rules

## General Rules

You will be given your bidder number as you check in at the door. Use this number for identification in both the Silent and Live Auctions.

All auction items have been donated to Our Lady of Mount Carmel School and may not be returned, refunded or exchanged. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. All auction items are sold “AS IS.” Mount Carmel School makes no warranties or representations of any kind with respect to items or services purchased. Values indicated for items are estimated as stated by donors and are not guaranteed by Mount Carmel School.

It is the *buyer's responsibility* to initiate contact with the donor of items to arrange for their use at mutually agreed times, unless otherwise specified. All items must be executed by October 26, 2014, unless otherwise specified. Any items not arranged by October 26, 2014 are not valid after that date and will be considered expired.

All purchased items should be removed from the premises by the end of the evening or on Sunday morning. Payment in full must be made immediately following the auction. You may pay for your items with check, or charge to your Visa, MasterCard, or American Express.

## Silent Auction

To make a bid, write your name, bidder number and the amount of your bid on the bid sheet. Each bidder is financially responsible for the use of his/her bid number. To be valid, the starting bid must be the minimum as shown, and each subsequent bid must be in increments specified on bid sheet. Each new bid must be written on the topmost blank line available on the bid sheet. New this year, “Guaranteed Purchase Price.” When you write your name and bidder number on the guaranteed price line, the bid sheet is pulled and the item is yours.

Auction officials will announce when the classroom closes. The highest bid recorded on the sheet at closing time will be the winning bid, circled by room hostess and submitted to bank. If the highest bid was not in the required increment over the previous bid, the previous bid will be declared the winner. In the event of a dispute, school administration has the sole and final discretion in determining the winning bid.

## Multiple Bid Items

As indicated on specific bid sheets, these items will be listed at a specific price for a maximum number of people to purchase. Once the maximum number of bidders is met, the item will close.

## Live Auction

To enter a bid, promptly raise your paddle high in the air so our Auctioneer and spotters can clearly see your bid number. The Auctioneer will acknowledge bids and the winning bidder at his sole discretion. Once the Auctioneer determines a winning bid, the title then passes to that bidder, who assumes all responsibility for and is liable to pay the full purchase price of the item. Please leave your bidder paddle on the table at the end of the evening.

## Bank

The bank is located in “A Kids Place.” Please allow at least 45 minutes after the close of the live auction for the bank to open. You can also return on Sunday, October 27th between 9:30 and noon to check out and pick up your items. Please carefully review your check out statement. If you have an error or question about your statement, please bring this to the attention of the bank staff or auction chair as soon as possible in order for them to edit the statement before the final submission for payment.

## **Fund-a-Need: Large Hall Renovation**

This year's Fund-a-Need is for the renovation of the large hall. The OLMC large hall was built in 1932 as a church. This structure has functioned as a church, an auditorium, a gymnasium and a general gathering spot for the OLMC parish and school community for over 81 years. This room is used almost every day by the OLMC community.

The money we raise at Auction 2013 will go towards the replacement of all the windows, an improved sound system and needed electrical upgrades. We hope to add additional stage lighting and a water fountain. The renovation will also include a much-needed sanding and refinishing of the floors, followed by painting the hall, stage and bathroom areas.

Our goal for this year's Fund-a-Need is \$20,000.

## **Heads or Tails Game**
